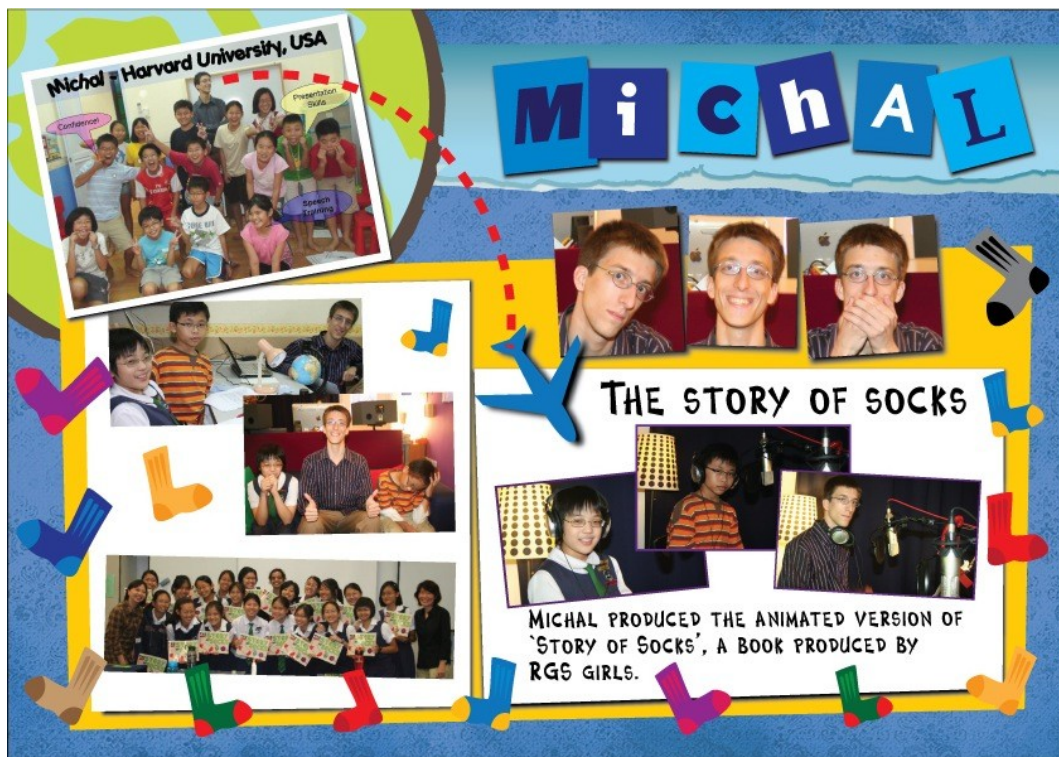


## Summer 2008
